## Creating A Catalogue

The first thing you will need to do when you have installed Lightroom is to make a new catalogue. Don't be frightened by the word Catalogue because it is just a collection of your images shown in one place.

### Create a New Catalogue.

Click on the Lightroom icon on your desktop or in Programs to open Lightroom. You will now be presented with a dialogue box asking where you wish to store your Catalogue if you have already done this process then Open Lightroom go to File>New Catalogue. Navigate to My Pictures then create a new folder and call it Lightroom, then give your Catalogue a unique name and click on Save. Lightroom will now generate a new Catalogue and open it in the Library module.

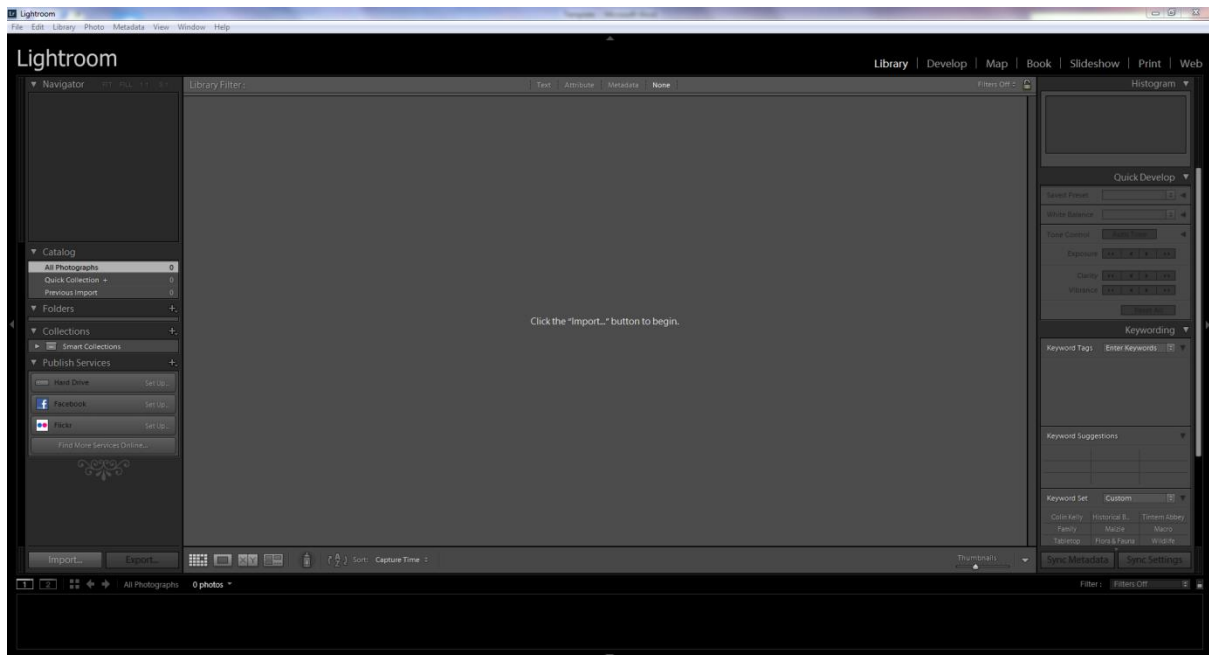


Fig 1 Library Module

We can now start to customise Lightroom to suit our needs.

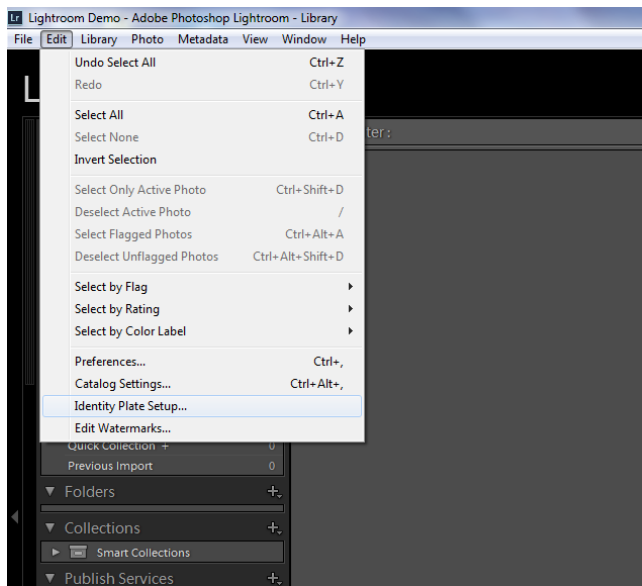

Go to Edit > Identity Plate Setup (fig 3)

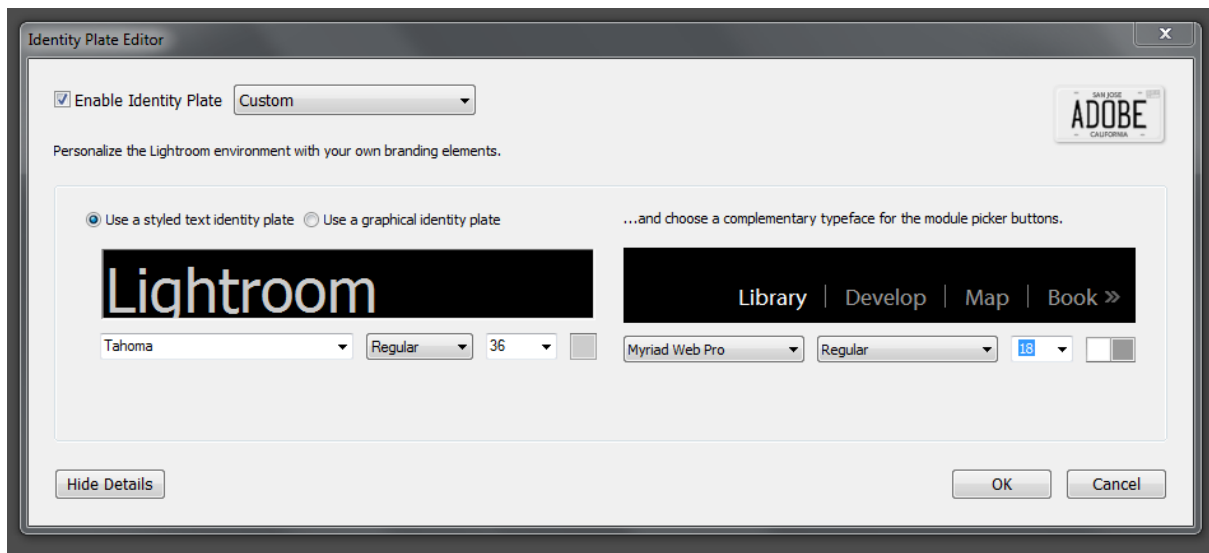
